

City & Guilds (2396) Level 4 Award in Design, Erection and Verification of Electrical Installations Course Information Sheet 011

Introduction

This course is for electricians with practical experience of inspection and testing of electrical installations, who wish to become certificated in the design, erection and verification of electrical installations. Candidates will gain a full insight into circuit design and verification and the ability to design installations with confidence.

About the course

This course is intended for personnel who have responsibility for the quality of the design, specification, installation, and inspection and testing processes, and was previously certificated under City & Guilds 2400 Design, Erection and Verification of Electrical Installations. It covers all aspects of installation design including detailed circuit design calculations to the 18th Edition, in particular the implications of the Wiring Regulations for Electrical Installations in relation to the design and erection of new electrical installations.

Where is the course run?

At our Training Centres in Burgess Hill, West Sussex & Portchester, Hampshire

What qualifications do I need to have to do this course?

Only candidates who already hold a current 18th Edition Wiring Regulations qualification and a City & Guilds Level 3 Certificate in Inspection, Testing and Certification of Electrical Installations, 2391, or 2394/95 can be accepted onto this course.

You must be over 18 to take this assessment.

About the assessment

The assessment is in two parts:

- 3 hour written evening examination, open book with 10 questions (date and time of exam set by City & Guilds)
- City & Guilds set project (minimum 40 hours work), demonstrating your ability to design and consider erection methods for a typical installation, and to demonstrate practical competence in testing and inspection

Once you have completed all of the Assessment components, your project result will be uploaded to City & Guilds and your written paper will be sent off to a City & Guilds Examiner for marking. Results (and certificates where applicable) will be sent to us approximately 8 weeks after the written examination date. We will then write to you with notification of your examination result enclosing your certificate if all components have been taken and passed. We are not permitted to give assessment results over the telephone.

How long will it take?

The course is 4 days of theory based revision with the evening written examination in addition to this. It is usually offered once a week for four weeks. Candidates must also complete a City & Guilds set project (min 40 hours) in their own time after the course.

What does it cost?
