#### Introduction

revision + 2 days assessment

Core Domestic Gas Safety (CCN1), 3 days  
revision + 1 day assessment

TPCP1 – Test and purge up to & exceeding 1m<sup>3</sup>, 2  
days revision + 1 day assessment  
(TPCP1A is available on request)

ICPN1 - Commercial pipework in excess of  
35mm, ½ day revision + ½ day assessment.

CDGA1 – Direct fired commercial appliances, ½  
day revision + ½ day assessment

CIGA1 – Indirect fired commercial appliances, ½  
day revision + ½ day assessment

CORT1 – Overhead radiant and tube heaters, ½  
day revision + ½ day assessment

BMP1 – gas boosters, ½ day revision + ½ day  
assessment (Burgess Hill only)

We also offer the following commercial laundry assessments:

CCLNG1 – Core commercial laundry, 3 days  
revision + 1 day assessment (Portchester only)

CLE1 – Commercial laundry equipment, ½ day  
revision + 1 day assessment (Portchester only)

COCCLNG1 – Changeover to commercial laundry,  
1 day revision + 1 day assessment (Portchester  
only)

#### What qualifications do I need to have to do this course?

Our gas courses and assessments are suitable for Category 1 applicants who are able to provide evidence of their existing recognised gas qualifications, and Category 2/3 applicants who have successfully completed an approved managed learning programme such as our own Guild of Gas Fitting Operatives programme (GGFO).

#### Where are the assessments run?

At our Training Centres in Burgess Hill, West Sussex and Portchester, near Portsmouth.

#### About the assessments

Commercial Gas Assessments include practical and written assessments which are completed after the revision sessions. After your Assessment we will internally verify your paperwork within 10 working days and send it to the certification body ERS to be processed and uploaded to the Gas Safe Register. This can take up a further 10 working days and we offer fast track Certification if required – ask for further details. You will then receive a certificate and card directly from ERS for the assessments taken.

You should be aware that successful completion of the assessments does not automatically result in Gas Safe Registration. You should make a separate application to the Gas Safe Registration Scheme to be included on the Gas Safe Register.

#### What does it cost?

The costs will vary according to your training requirements, and we will tailor a package to meet your needs. Assessments may be taken without revision, and considerable discounts are available when assessments are booked as a package e.g. for customers renewing their ACS qualifications.

#### Preparation for the courses

When you have made your booking we will send you the paperwork including booking confirmation and invoice.

- Photo I.D. such as passport, driving licence, company I.D. card or GasSafe card (you will not be allowed to sit the assessment without this)
- Books will be issued on day one of the course.
