Available assessments include:

CCN1 - Core Domestic Gas Safety, 2 or 4 days revision + 2 days assessment	CPA1 - Combustion Performance Analysers, ½ day revision + ½ day assessment
ICPN1 ⁽²⁾ - Commercial pipework in excess of 35mm, ½ day revision + ½ day assessment.	REGT1 – Domestic Meters Medium Pressure Regulators, ½ day revision + ½ day assessment
CKR1 - Cookers, ½ day revision + ½ day assessment	CENWAT ⁽¹⁾ - Boilers and water heaters, ½ day revision + ½ day assessment
HTR1 - Fires, ½ day revision + ½ day assessment	DAH1 - Ducted air heaters, ½ day revision + ½ day assessment
MET1/2 - Meters, ½ day revision + ½ day assessment	HWB1 - Swimming pool boilers, ½ day revision + ½ day assessment
TPCP1/TPCP1A ⁽²⁾ – Test and purge up to & exceeding 1m ³ , 2 days revision + 1 day assessment	(TPCP1A, covering up to 1m ³ , is available on request)

⁽²⁾ These categories are generally associated with Commercial installations but they can be completed by domestic engineers who hold a current CCN1 e.g. where the engineer needs to test & purge installations with a volume over 0.035m³, or pipework over 35mm. Other restrictions apply if they choose TPCP1a (volume & pressure related), hence our usual offering of TPCP1

Where are the assessments run?

At our Training Centres in Burgess Hill, West Sussex and Portchester, near Portsmouth.

What qualifications do I need to have to do this course?

Our gas courses and assessments are suitable for Experienced Gas Engineers (previously known as Category 1 applicants) who are able to provide evidence of their existing recognised gas qualifications, and New Entrants with or without Transferable Skills or Experience (previously known as Category 2/3 applicants), who have successfully completed an approved managed learning programme such as our own Guild of Gas Fitting Operatives programme (GGFO).

About the assessments

Domestic Gas Assessments include practical and written assessments which are completed after the revision sessions. After your Assessment we will internally verify your paperwork within 10 working days and send it to the certification body ERS to be processed and uploaded to the Gas Safe Register. This can take up a further 10 working days and we offer fast track Certification if required – ask for further details. You will then receive a certificate and card directly from ERS for the assessments taken.

You should be aware that successful completion of the assessments does not automatically result in Gas Safe Registration. You should make a separate application to the Gas Safe Registration Scheme to be included on the Gas Safe Register.

What does it cost?

The costs will vary according to your training requirements, and we will tailor a package to meet your needs. Assessments may be taken without revision, and considerable discounts are available when assessments are booked as a package e.g. for customers renewing their ACS qualifications.

Preparation for the courses

When you have made your booking we will send you the paperwork including booking confirmation and invoice.

What will I need?

You should bring the following with you to your course:

- Pen, paper and non-programmable scientific calculator
- If renewing, your previous certificate (original document not photocopy)
- Photo I.D. such as passport, driving licence, company I.D. card or GasSafe card (you will not be allowed to sit the assessment without this)

We will verify your identity and take your photo on arrival.
