Introduction

This course is intended for qualified electricians with practical experience of inspection and testing of electrical installations, who require certification in this area of their work. This updated programme replaces City & Guilds 2394 / 2395, and each option will now take the form of one practical examination and an open book multiple choice exam.

All candidates must hold the 18th Edition qualification to take this course.

About the course

There are three assessment options available to cater for all requirements.

If you work on new installations you will need the initial verification qualification, for older installations there is periodic inspection and testing, and the combined qualification will cover you for both.

The assessment options are:

- **Option 1 – 2391-50 Initial Verification only**
 - Equivalent to 2394
 - Practical exercises + 1 open book multiple choice exam paper
- **Option 2 – 2391-51 Periodic Inspection & Testing only**
 - Equivalent to 2395
 - Practical exercises + 1 open book multiple choice exam paper
- **Option 3 – 2391-52 Combined Initial Verification and Periodic Inspection & Testing**
 - Combined qualification equivalent to 2394 + 2395
 - Practical exercises + 1 open book multiple choice exam paper

The course can be run on demand to suit you, with no fixed exam dates
Results will now be available on the day of the exam

This qualification remains recognised by the electrical industry as the benchmark for those who carry out initial verification as well as periodic inspection and testing activities.

There is considerable overlap between the initial verification and periodic inspection & testing assessments. We therefore deliver one training course that meets the needs of delegates taking all three options.

Where is the course run?

At our Training Centres in Burgess Hill, West Sussex and Portchester, near Portsmouth.

What qualifications do I need to have to do this course?

This course is for experienced qualified electricians.

In addition to relevant practical experience, candidates must possess a current 18th Edition Wiring Regulations qualification (eg C&G 2382).

Candidates holding an older qualification (17th Edition) must update before taking this course

Candidates who already hold C&G 2394 may complete their training by taking either the combined 2391 options or just the 2391-51 as the equivalent to the old 2395 qualification.

You must be over 18 to take this assessment.

About the assessment

Assessments for all three options will take the form of a practical session and one open book multiple choice exam paper.

The individual assessments (2391-50 and 2391-51) will be 40 question exam papers, and the combined qualification (2391-52) will have a longer 60 question paper.

Results will be issued on the day of the exam.

How long will it take?

7 days of classroom based theory revision plus the practical and written exams.

What is the next step?

The next qualification for most people would be the Level 4 C&G 2396 design and erection qualification.
